

ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

Recycling of certain electronic items became mandatory on January 1, 2011 according to new State, County, and local requirements.

ELECTRONICS WILL NOT BE COLLECTED

These items will not be collected and may be brought to the Borough Electronic Recycling Drop-off or any recycling facility which is permitted to accept them.

Keyboards, Mice
Monitors, scanners
Laptops, peripherals
Televisions
Radios & CD players
Cameras
VCR's, DVD Players
Stereo components

**Additional non-mandatory items
may be brought to the Borough
drop-off center for recycling.**
