

# RULES AND STANDARDS

## TROOP 124

“SWIPE”d (*Stolen with Integrity, Pride & Enthusiasm*) from Troop 32

**The Scout *Oath* and *Law* are the code of conduct expected in our troop. If in doubt, repeat the oath and law to yourself.**

- Dues are \$1 per Meeting. Dues are to be paid weekly.
- Fund Raiser - is held once yearly, Participation is encouraged to help raise funds for the betterment of your Troop.
- Uniforms (Class A or B) will be properly worn at all troop activities unless otherwise specified. This means all meetings, outings, hikes, campouts, etc.
- Troop meetings are on Monday evenings from 7:30 to 9:00 at Luther Memorial Church, Tinton Avenue, Tinton Falls, NJ, unless otherwise noted on Troop Calendar.
- Junior Leaders will meet once each month to plan Troop campouts, meetings, etc. Patrol Leaders Council Meetings are held at The Luther Memorial Church, unless noted otherwise.
- All outings, hikes, meetings, campouts, etc. are to be planned and carried out by the troop members. Get involved in the planning if you don't like the existing program. Adult leaders are here for guidance and counseling only. Scouts - Remember - "IT IS YOUR TROOP."
- Each patrol is responsible for obtaining transportation for its members for each outing. Failure to obtain transportation may cause your patrol to miss the outing, so be sure each family does its share of the driving.
- In planning campouts, all menus, and lists of drivers and number of tents needed for each patrol are to be shown to the Senior Patrol Leader and Scoutmaster at the troop meeting two meetings before the outing.
- Discipline and other problems are to be handled by the Patrol Leaders Council under the leadership of the Senior Patrol Leader with the guidance of the Scoutmaster, if needed.
- If you are going to miss a meeting or any activity, please notify your Patrol Leader or the Senior Patrol Leader.
- The position of Senior Patrol Leader can be held only by a troop member who has been active in the troop for at least 12 consecutive months prior to troop elections, is at least Star, and who has shown his leadership abilities to the satisfaction of the Patrol Leaders Council.
