SPECIAL CURBSIDE CARDBOARD COLLECTION

A special “cardboard only” collection will be done on Friday, January 5th for those homes currently using “single stream” blue automated carts placed at their curb. This special collection will be for all of those extra Holiday corrugated cardboard boxes! Please place cardboard flattened and tied at the curb by 7:00 am.

Christmas trees may be placed for collection from January 8, 2018 through January 12, 2018. After January 12th, Christmas trees will be collected with the normal brush and branch collection. You may also bring your tree to the Recycling Center located behind Borough Hall. Multifamily dwellings should check with their Association or Management Company for the location of Christmas tree collection.

SNOW EVENT PARKING BAN

Borough Ordinance 7-3.3

Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the streets or highways within the Borough, an emergency shall exist, and no vehicle shall be parked on any street or portion thereof.

The parking prohibition shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the streets have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic.

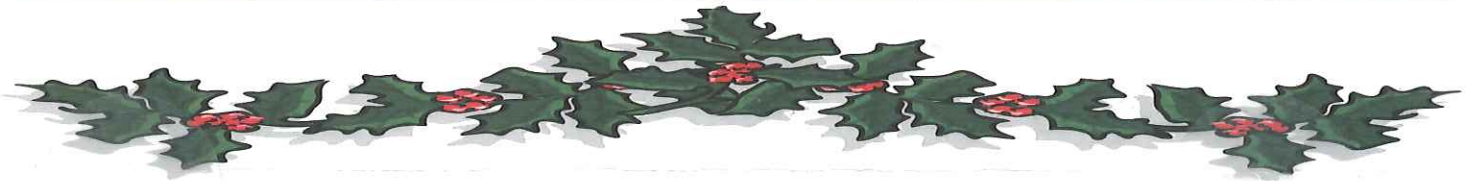

BOROUGH HOLIDAY CURBSIDE SCHEDULE

For those residents who would normally have *curbside* refuse collection on Tuesday, December 26th, collection will instead take place on Thursday, December 28th. Residents normally having *curbside* recycling collection on Thursday, December 28th, will instead have collection on Friday, December 29th.
