Monmouth County Clerk Hanlon Advises Sample Ballots for the 2024 General Election Are Available

Sample ballots have been mailed to voters and are available online

FREEHOLD, NJ – Monmouth County Clerk Christine Giordano Hanlon is advising voters that sample ballots for the November 5th General Election are now available.

Sample ballots are being mailed to voters in all 53 Monmouth County municipalities and can also be accessed online by visiting the Monmouth County Clerk’s elections website or free mobile app.

“Sample ballots help voters familiarize themselves with the ballot format and the candidates for each office,” said Clerk Hanlon. “As it has been in every presidential election, voter turnout is expected to be high, so the sample ballot is a great resource to help voters come prepared to polls.”

Voters can access their sample ballots online by visiting the Sample Ballot section of the Monmouth County Clerk’s elections website at <https://www.monmouthcountyvotes.com/elections/sample-ballots/>. To navigate to the page from the homepage, MonmouthCountyVotes.com, scroll over “Elections” on the top menu bar and choose “Sample Ballots” from the drop-down menu. From the Monmouth County Votes mobile app, select the “Sample Ballots” icon.
