Monmouth County Clerk Hanlon Advises Sample Ballots for the Primary Election Are Available

Sample ballots are mailed to voters and are available online

FREEHOLD, NJ – Monmouth County Clerk Christine Giordano Hanlon is advising voters that sample ballots for the upcoming June 4th Primary Election are now available.

Sample ballots are being mailed to voters in all 53 Monmouth County municipalities and can also be accessed online by visiting the Monmouth County Clerk’s elections website or free mobile app.

“Sample ballots are very helpful for voters, since they can help familiarize a voter with the ballot format as well as the candidates for each office,” said Clerk Hanlon. “It is important for all voters to review their sample ballots to make the process at the polls easier.”

To access a sample ballot online, visit the Sample Ballot section of the Monmouth County Clerk’s elections website at <https://www.monmouthcountyvotes.com/elections/sample-ballots/>. To navigate to the page from the homepage, MonmouthCountyVotes.com, scroll over “Elections” on the top menu bar and choose “Sample Ballots” from the drop-down menu. From the Monmouth County Votes mobile app, select the “Sample Ballots” icon.
